in an internet world

There was a time...

- Information was only available via libraries
- Collecting and organizing info was the only way to find/have access to it
- Otlet and La Fontaine wanted to make a big universal bibliography of human knowledge (répertoire bibliographique universel)
 - Their tool: the Universal Decimal Classification (UDC)

Now...

- The quantity of information keeps growing
- The quantity of information outside libraries is enormous
- The internet is fundamentally unorganized (one big “data soup”)
- Information changes very quickly
- Collecting and organizing the world’s knowledge seem to have become an impossible ambition

Besides

- Search engines make us find/access information => no need for organizing
- Everybody is an information amateur: everybody publishes, everybody shares information, everybody tags information, ...
- The web is becoming social and organizes itself

UDC

- design for broad use and easy access: librarian's tool => user's tool: help the user, not complicate things
- maximize the retrievability/visibility of information: e.g. clustering, browsing
- enrich bib info in the background
- automatic indexing/classification

Basic Search

Base to search: All LIBIS-Catalogues

Field to search: Type word or phrase Exact Phrase?

Any Word No Yes

Limit the search to

Search Clear

Search hints:

- **Names:** always type the **last name first**, followed by the first name and select **Exact Phrase = YES**. If you are not sure of the first name, type the first character of the first name, followed by ? and select Exact Phrase = YES.
Example: *shakespeare william* (Exact Phrase = YES) / *shakespeare w?* (Exact Phrase = YES).
- **Exact Phrase:** select YES if you want to search for exact combinations of TWO words.
Example: *foreign affairs, computer programming*.
- **? and *** allows you to search on parts of words.
Example: *gun?* will retrieve gun, guns, gunners, gunnery, gunning, etc.
Example: *?osmos* will retrieve kosmos, cosmos, macrocosmos, etc.
Example: *alumi?m* will find both the American spelling, aluminum, and the British spelling, alum inium. For a complete list of [Wild cards](#), see Help.
- Boolean **AND is assumed** between words.
- You can use the Boolean operators **AND, OR** and **NOT** in the search string.
Example: *(heart OR cardio) AND surgery* will give all records having heart or cardiac together with the word surgery.
- No distinction is made between **lowercase** and **CAPITALS**.
Example: *aristoteles* will find matches for ARISTOTELES, Aristoteles and aristoteles.

Internet

Metadata

- Formal and subject metadata should be integrated and combined in an intelligent way
- Maximize, enrich and visualize info in order to make it easily retrievable: less organization, more visibility/retrievability
- Automation (cost-effectiveness)

Library systems

- Visible (“leak out”) on the internet
- As intelligent and user-friendly as search machines (avoid frustration: “the OPAC sucks”):
 - Only show what the user wants to know
 - Make the user curious
 - Give the user several chances
 - Enrich the catalog with services (“more like this”, “get it”, new book lists, RSS ...) and data (cover art, reviews, TOC’s, ...)

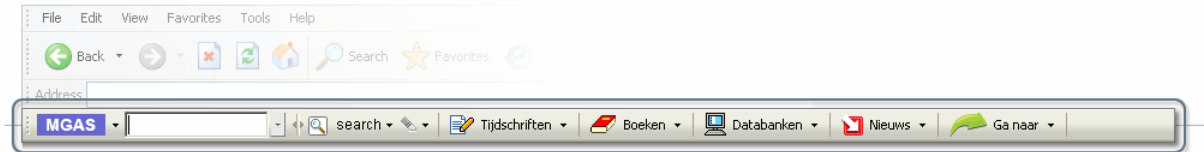

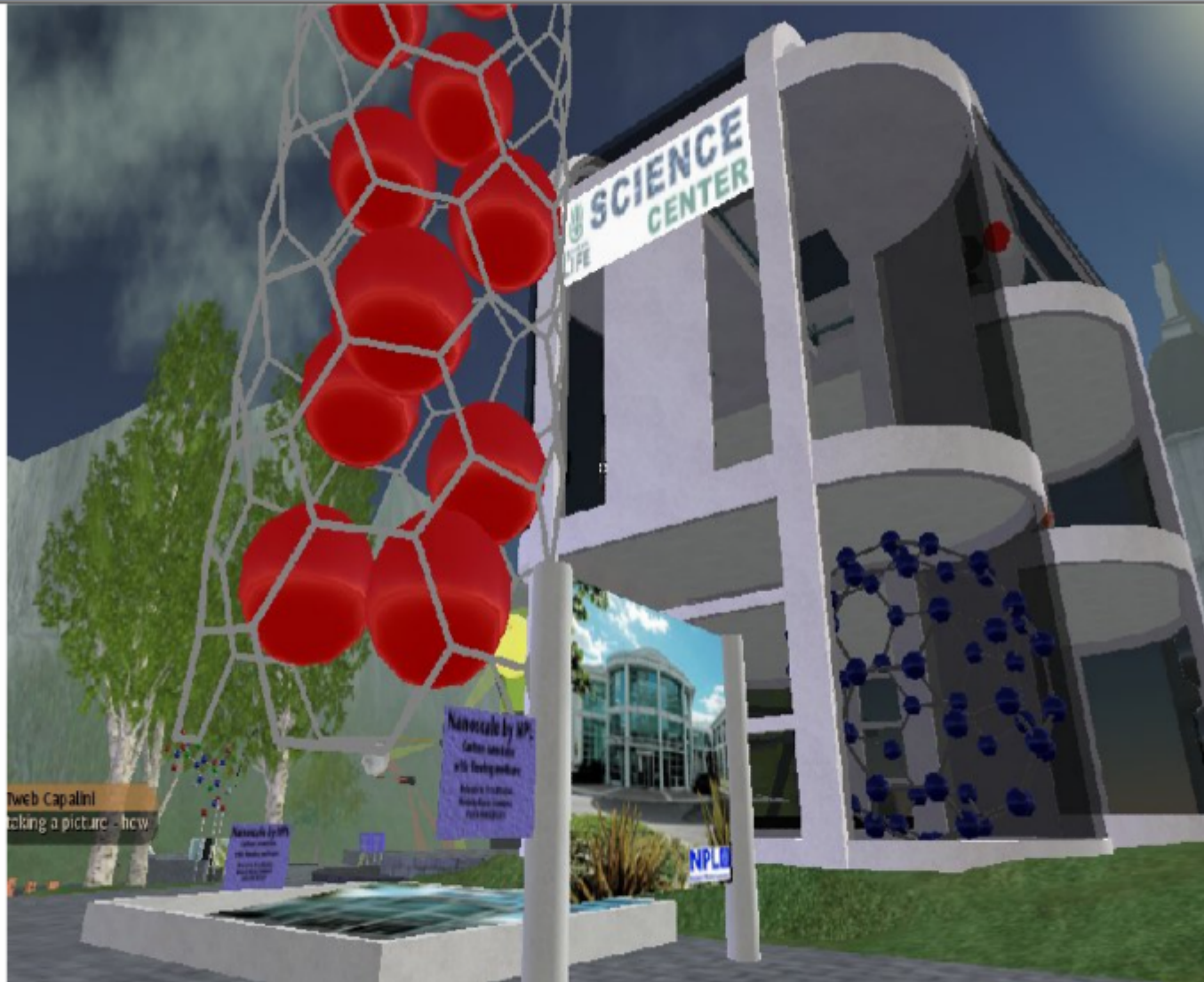
