DISHONEST SCHOLASTIC WORK: The Senate voted to deny the motion to substitute an alternative plan for Part III of the recommendation submitted by the Cheating Review Committee. The substitute plan would have provided for a Committee on Dishonest Scholastic Work and would have allowed the instructor (a) to determine the guilt of the student, award a penalty not in excess of a grade of 5, and inform the Committee on Dishonest Work of the incident and penalty; or (b) alternatively to refer the entire problem with appropriate evidence to the committee for action and disposition.

PART III, SECTION C, (5) OF CHEATING REVIEW COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: A revised statement of this section was referred to the Cheating Review Committee for rewording.

STUDENT BODY ASSEMBLIES, REQUEST FOR: A request received from the student body president for approval of two assemblies in addition to that for Mothers' and Dads' Day during the first semester was tabled pending presentation of pertinent information by the Dean of Men.

CHEATING CASES, CONSIDERATION OF: The Senate asked that the Committee on Student Examinations and Reports be continued to handle cases of cheating until the Senate has an opportunity to take final action on the report of the Cheating Review Committee.

SPECIAL MEETING: The Senate will hold a special meeting on Monday, November fifteenth, to continue consideration of items now on the agenda.
