Meeting of Monday

February 4, 1957

Faculty Lounge, re-location of: The Senate heard a report from Mr. Marvin D. Johnson, Director of the Student Union, covering the use of the Faculty Lounge during a period of forty-six days in November, December, and January. It was apparent that the lounge is used by a limited number of the faculty and that it is not possible to effectively administer the sale of coffee made available in the lounge.

The proposal of the Student Union Policy Board submitted several months ago, that the Lounge be moved to Room 257, was considered at some length. A show of hands indicated that eighteen members of the Senate favored the change to Room 257 while eight favored retention of the present quarters. Mr. Johnson was advised that the transfer of the Lounge to Room 257 of the Student Union Building was in order. Coffee will be available from the area adjoining Room 257 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m.

Committee Reports: Reports of special committees of the Senate were not available, but it was indicated that these would be submitted at the next meeting of the Senate.
