

PROCEEDINGS OF THE FACULTY SENATE
Meeting of Monday February 1, 1954


The meeting of the Faculty Senate convened in regular session at 3:40 o'clock on Monday, February 1, 1954, in Room 101 of the Law Building. Twenty-seven members were present with President Harvill presiding.

COMMITTEE TO STUDY ABSENCES: President Harvill announced appointment of the following committee to Study the Problem of Absences: Dr. L. E. Roberts - Chairman, James A. Beatson, Fred O. Bogart, P. J. Danielson, and Quentin R. Thomson.

CATALOG MATERIAL: The Senate accepted without objection a report on new Regular Session, Summer Session and Extension Division courses as approved by the Advisory Council during the period September 16, 1953 through January 20, 1954. Included in the report was the announcement of a new program leading to the Doctor of Philosophy in Nutrition. The following members of the faculty have been added to the Nutrition Committee: H. L. REGISTRATION COMMITTEE; REPORT OF: Registrar Leshner, Chairman of the Committee to Study Registration Policies and Procedures, reported that the Faculty Committee working in cooperation with the Student Committee had studied the second semester plan of registration and found several points which need adjustment. The Committee will make a report to the Senate later, after considering further a student proposal that the University institute a plan of pre-registration.
