Catalogue material, approval of: The Senate approved additional catalogue material which had been processed through the Coordinating Committee and the Advisory Council.

Committee of Eleven, report of membership in: It was reported that Mr. Donald Powell of the Library Staff had been elected to membership in the Committee of Eleven by members of that committee. Mr. Powell succeeds Dr. Melvin Solve.

Final examinations, recommendation re: The President appointed a special committee to study the question of final examinations for seniors as related to commencement and as submitted by the Committee of Eleven. The committee is as follows: Professor Barnes, Dean Brewer, Professor Conley, Professor Hall, Mr. Leshner (ex-officio), and Dr. Roberts, with Dr. Roberts acting as Chairman.

Degree requirements, method of administering: The Senate asked the President to appoint a special committee to study the method of administering petitions for adjustments in degree requirements.
