

MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE FACULTY SENATE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF ARIZONA

HONORARY DEGREES, APPROVAL OF: The Senate received four recommendations for the awarding of honorary degrees at Commencement on May 29, 1963. The Senate voted to recommend to the General Faculty and the Board of Regents the awarding of these honorary degrees - two Doctor of Laws and two Doctor of Letters degrees.

COMMENTS BY PRESIDENT HARVILL: President Harvill reviewed briefly with the Senate the status of legislation concerning the University of Arizona currently under consideration by the State Legislature. The President reported that never in the history of the institution had friends of the University worked so effectively in behalf of the institution in its effort to obtain the appropriation of state funds needed by the University. The President explained that the full operating budget, including the \$160,000 for the planning of the medical school, had been approved. He said how much of the amount requested for the capital building program and land acquisition would be appropriated remained to be seen.
