1. **COURSEWORK:** Completing a course that satisfies criteria developed by the Curriculum Committee
 - LIBR 100: Introduction to Library Studies
 - LIBR 105: Advanced Online Research
 - BUSW 530: Introduction to the Internet
 - CIS 110: Introduction to Computer and Information Science
 - DGME100: Media In Society
 - DGME 102: Media Law & Ethics
 - NURS 242: Leadership/Management in Nursing (Under development)
 - MATH 145: Liberal Arts Mathematics (Under Development)

2. **EXAM:**

Earning a score of 70% or higher on the CSM Information Competency Proficiency Exam.

3. **EQUIVALENCY:**

Earning a grade of C (or higher) or P in an equivalent course taken outside of the SMCCCD that meets the College of San Mateo Standard for Information Competency.
