


Eller First Semester Cohort


- 400 to 500 juniors enter business school every semester; very competitive admissions process between sophomore/junior years.
- All students take the same 4 classes: business communication, finance, marketing, management, plus an elective.
- Business communications, marketing, and management classes are closely coordinated.
- Business communications has 3 tracks: traditional management, global business, and consulting services group.
- Team consisted of 2 finance professors, 1 marketing professor, 1 management professor, 8 writing instructors, and 3 librarians.
- Major milestones: first day of class kick-off in main auditorium, 2 or 3 team projects, kick-off for case competition, and end-ofsemester case competition.

Blackboard First Semester Toolkit

- Resources organized into 5 topic folders.
- Same resource could be in multiple folders.
- All training docs available at point of use.
- Screen shots give stepby-step guidance








First Semester Kick-Off

- Two classes of about 250 students each.
- Jason led a 50-minute session on business research. Erica & Cheryl provided roving help.
- Students were asked to bring laptops to class.
- Got hands-on practice using databases.
- Questions were randomized to thwart cheating.





End-of-Session Feedback

- Had technical problems with Wi-Fi access.


End-of-Semester Feedback


Post-Class Assignment


- Required to complete 4 side-by-side tutorials and 3 quizzes within 2 days.
- Each quiz had 5 blocks of randomized questions.
- Students were required to answer 4 out of 5 questions correct.
- BSC tutorial averaged around 22 minutes, Mergent around 15 minutes, NAICS & Ibis 4 minutes each.



Case Competition

- End of semester capstone consulting project.
- Used a data visualization tool called "Spicy Nodes" (top right) to show available data.
- Created three tutorials between 8 and 14 minutes with Blackboard Collaborate.





Outcomes

- Now a part of the Eller First Semester Team.
- Expanding online self-help resources.
- Part of the design for the planned online undergraduate curriculum.
- Library tab will be added to every course in Blackboard.
