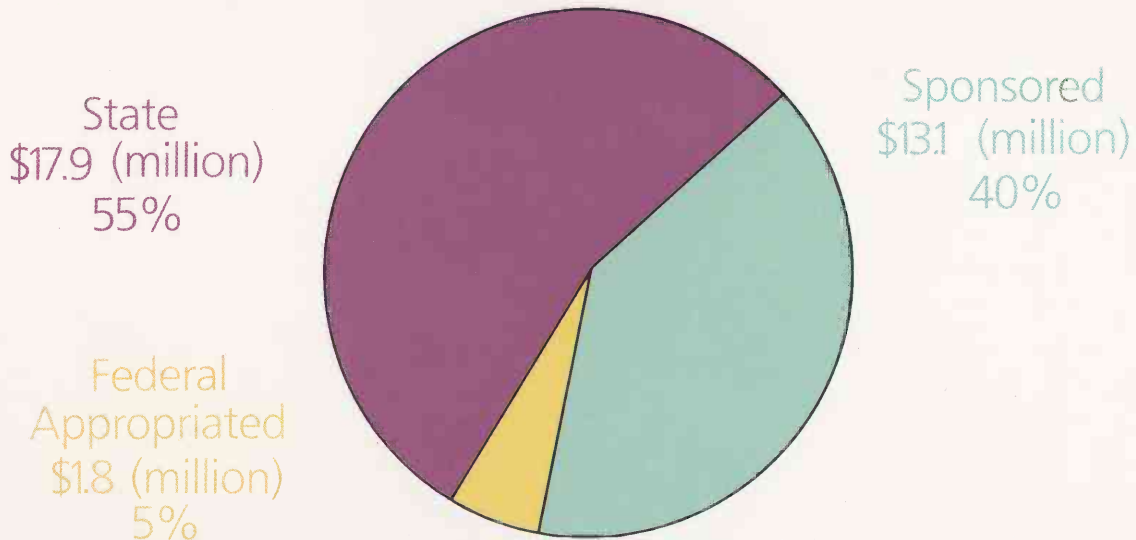
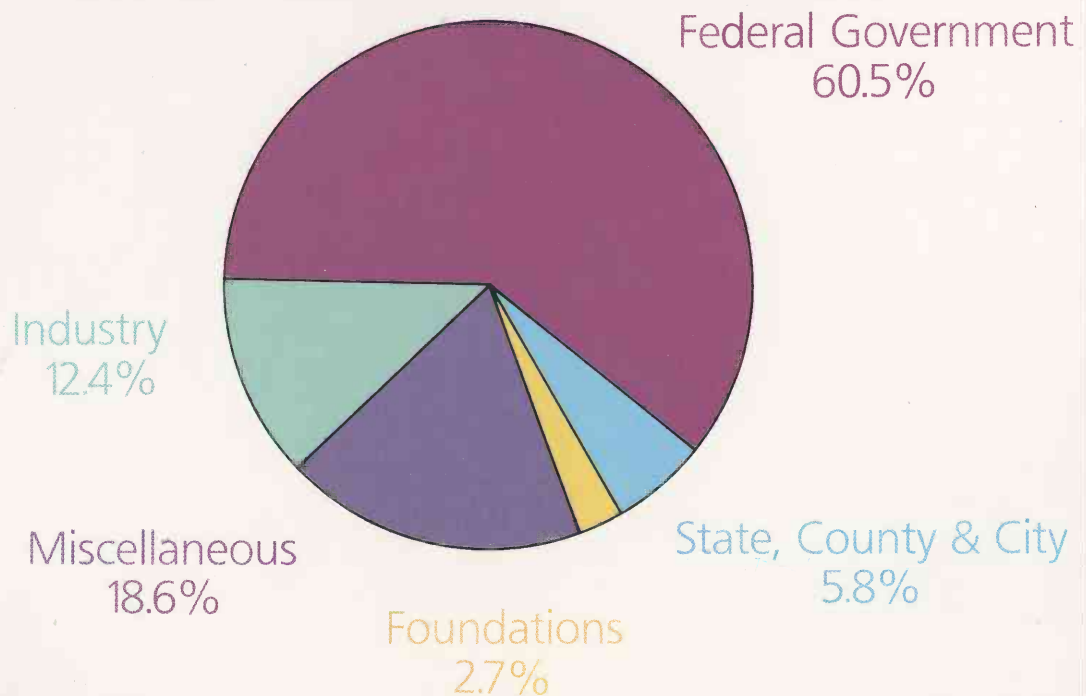


Total Research Funding Fiscal 1990 (\$32.8 million)
