REMARKS--

Due to the fact that the former County Agricultural Agent, Mr. Lee H. Gould, has turned in his reports covering his period of work, I am only reporting the work in my Narrative Report that I have done since I have been here.

I have included the figures of the former County Agent's statistical report in that of mine and have so marked the report showing how much time both of us have represented in the report.

During the month of October, while there was no Agent on duty in this County, Mr. Gould attended many meetings and answered questions pertaining to the Extension Work in this County.

The County Farm Bureau association held its annual election of officers at Patagonia on October 30th. Mr. A.M. Benjamin of Sonoma was elected President, Mr. E. S. Magruder of Amado was elected Vice-President, and Mr. Lee H. Gould of Nogales, Secretary.

So far, none of the local organizations have started their winter meetings, but as soon as I become better acquainted I am going to see if I can't get an organization going in each of the five communities.

OUTLOOK AND RECOMMENDATIONS--

While there are no actual figures to date on the onion or buckwheat tests that were conducted this past season, I am of the opinion that further and more extensive tests should be carried on in order to get figures for a comprehensive report. I also believe that some tests should be carried on with Fall lettuce growing in the Valley, also continue the work that has been started in walnut grafting, irrigation, poultry, dairy husbandry, and rodent control.

SUMMARY--

There has not been any projects actually started or completed since the 1st of November. My principal work has been getting acquainted with people and getting familiar with the work that has been done by the former Agent.
