LSC 94 continues the series of conferences held in Gatlinburg, USA in 1989 and Vienna, Austria in 1992. The conference venue will be the Royal Scottish Academy of Music and Drama in Glasgow, Scotland, from 8-12 August 1994. This is the week before the 15th International Radiocarbon Conference, which will also be held at the same location.

The aims of the conference are to promote and encourage the free exchange of information on liquid scintillation spectrometry and related scintillation techniques.

The proposed scientific themes are:

New Instrumentation
Advances in Liquid and Solid Scintillators
Bioscience Applications
Environmental Applications
Alpha Counting
Cerenkov Counting
Data Handling Algorithms/Computer Applications and Software
Sample Handling and Disposal
Other Scintillation Techniques

Contributed papers are welcomed within the themes outlined above and authors are required to submit a 500-word abstract by 31 December 1993 for refereeing. There will also be a major exhibition of the latest commercial instrumentation for liquid scintillation spectrometry and displays of ancillary equipment, supplies and books.
