

EDITORIAL STATEMENT TO CONTRIBUTORS

Since its inception, the basic purpose of Radiocarbon has been the publication of compilations of ^{14}C dates produced by various laboratories. These lists are extremely useful for the dissemination of basic ^{14}C information.

In recent years, Radiocarbon has also been publishing technical and interpretative articles on all aspects of ^{14}C . The editors and readers agree that this expansion is broadening the scope of the Journal. This year, the editors announce the publication of the proceedings of the 10th International Radiocarbon Conference that was held at Bern and Heidelberg, August 19-26, 1979. Volume 22, Nos. 2 and 3, 1980 will contain these proceedings.

Subscribers will receive these issues at the regular subscription price, which has been raised to \$60.00 for institutions and \$40.00 for individuals. Non-subscribers may order the special publications separately at \$35.00. Volume 22, 1980 will include four numbers.
